

Block 1 | A Good Fence Makes A Good Neighbor

For our first block, we're revisiting the our dear friend the Rail Fence block, with special focus on featuring directional fabrics thoughtfully. Rather than a cutting list for this block, you'll find a fabric gathering list below. We'll do the cutting together in the video. With directional prints, cutting in one direction first can limit what's possible afterward, so this approach helps us preserve flexibility and make the most of every inch.

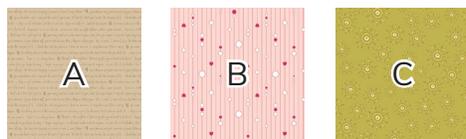

Whether you are using these exact fabrics or substituting from your own stash, be sure to choose either a 14-piece or 21-piece layout. Selecting one of these two options will allow us to map your quilt accurately within the appropriate specifications. We'll make (8) blocks this week with various configurations of our fabrics, depending on the direction of our prints.
