

Block 2 | A Stitch in Time

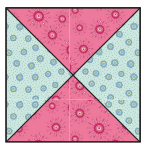
A Stitch in Time is a classic hourglass block, where two triangles meet and cross in perfect balance. As one of quilting's most foundational units, it teaches precision, patience, and trust in the process. Simple on its own, powerful when repeated, it reminds us that quilts, like confidence, are built one thoughtful stitch at a time... and in our case, one week at a time.

Whether you are using these exact fabrics or substituting from your own stash, be sure to choose either a 14-piece or 21-piece layout. 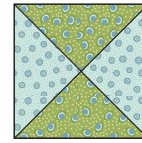

Afternoon Delight - 21-piece (scrappier fabric range)

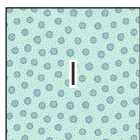

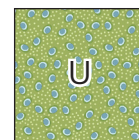
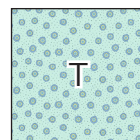
From Each, Cut:



Wall: (2) - 5 ¼" squares

Lap: (2) - 7 ¼" squares

Queen: (2) - 9 ¼" squares



Note: If you prefer a little extra trimming room, cut your squares ¼" larger, 5 ½", 7 ½ or 9 ½.
