How to Make a Standard Quilt Block Into A Scrappy Mosaic One!

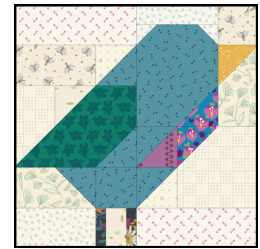


18" or 24" finished

To make the block above, we begin by examining how it began (right), as our Weekly Whim 1 sew along Block 9 - A Moment to Mend. While scrappiness does exist in the original version, We can make it scrappier!



Materials for 18" Block:

Background:

- (81) - 2" squares
- (8) - 2 ½" or 2 ¾" squares
- (4) - 1 ¼" x 2" rectangles

Bird Body:

- (22) - 2" squares
- (12) - 2 ½" or 2 ¾" squares

Bird Tummy:

- (3) - 2" squares
- (3) - 2 ½" or 2 ¾" squares

Bird Wing:

- (12) - 2" squares
- (4) - 2 ½" or 2 ¾" squares

Bird Beak:

- (1) - 2" square
- (1) - 2 ½" or 2 ¾" square

Bird Legs:

- (4) - 1 ¼" x 2" rectangles

Backing & Batting: (1) 26" square of each

Materials for 24" Block:

Background:

- (81) - 2 ½" squares
- (8) - 3" or 3 ¼" squares
- (4) - 1 ¾" x 2 ½" rectangles

Bird Body:

- (22) - 2 ½" squares
- (12) - 3" or 3 ¼" squares

Bird Tummy:

- (3) - 2 ½" squares
- (3) - 3" or 3 ¼" squares

Bird Wing:

- (12) - 2 ½" squares
- (4) - 3" or 3 ¼" squares

Bird Beak:

- (1) - 2 ½" square
- (1) - 3" or 3 ¼" squares

Bird Legs:

- (4) - 1 ¾" x 2 ½" rectangles

Backing & Batting: (1) 32" square of each

Binding (for either size): (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
A bead or button is optional if you'd like your bird to have an eye.
