

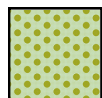
Summertime Scrappy Season Episode 8: A Breezy Block

Cutting Instructions, For (1) Block:



Fabric A:

(1) - 7 ¼" square



Fabric B:

(4) - 2 ⅝" x 5 ⅛" rectangles

(2) - 3 ⅞" squares

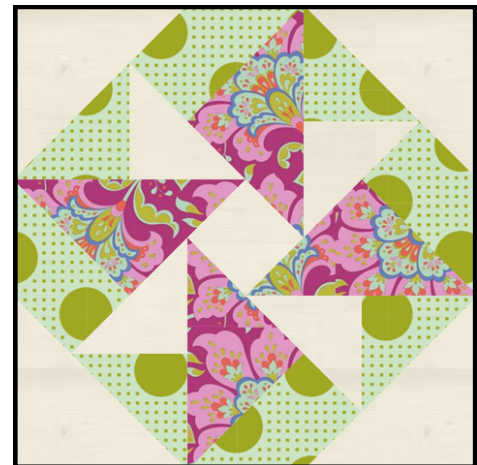


Fabric C:

(2) - 5 ⅜" squares

(2) - 3 ⅞" squares

(1) - 2 ⅝" square



12" finished



28" finished

If you've ever shied away from making a quilt block because you read the words: **PARTIAL SEAM** as you skimmed the instructions - Shy away no more!

In the associated tutorial, I'll walk you through making the Breezy Block (above) and teach you how breezy partial seams can be. We'll also expand our quilty brains on how to create a larger project (such as the wallhanging at left), with a little pizzazz with a few extra additions.

Additional Cuts as needed for the Optional Wallhanging:

Accents: (8) - 2 ½" squares

Border 1: (2) - 1 ½" x 24 ½" rectangles, (2) 1 ½" x 26 ½" rectangles

Border 2: (2) - 1 ½" x 26 ½" rectangles, (2) 1 ½" x 28 ½" rectangles

Binding: (3) - 2 ½" x WOF or leftover scraps from project
