

Summertime Scrappy Season Episode 11: A Basket for Your Burrow

Materials for (1) Basket:

From Assorted Scraps:

(40) - 1 ½" squares **OR** (10) 2 ½" squares

From Background (Outside):



(2) - 11" wide x 4" tall rectangles

(2) - 11" wide x 6" tall rectangles

Lining Fabric (Inside):

(2) 11" wide x 10" tall rectangles

Foldover Cuff:

(2) 11" wide x 2" tall rectangles



7" tall - finished

*If one continuous fabric is preferred for lining and cuff, you will need (2) 11" wide x 12" tall rectangles for lining fabric

Fusible Interfacing:

(2) 10 ½" wide x 11" tall rectangles

- I recommend Pellon 808 Craft-Fuse.

Michael's is a great source

One of the most useful things I've found for scraps, bits or bobs of all kinds, either in the studio or elsewhere, is a fabric basket. It's also incredibly easy to make!

This basket can be used for so many things. It's great for scraps, a holder for a square tissue box, a waste basket for the car, and it makes the perfect gift!
